

Key Objective

To represent health working as part of a multi-disciplinary team at the Integrated Front Door, contributing specialist health knowledge to support the identification and assessment of safeguarding contacts. The role ensures that health information is effectively shared and used to support timely, evidence-based decisions to enable effective safeguarding and family help practices to flourish.

Tasks Specific to this Role

Working as part of a multi-disciplinary team in the Integrated Front Door, whilst also working autonomously
To facilitate the sharing of information between partner agencies, including obtaining and clarifying information to enable effective safeguarding and family help practices to flourish.
Facilitate the completion of health checks, gather, analyse and interpret health records and build chronologies to enhance evidence-based decision making on contacts to the integrated front where proportionate and necessary to strengthen outcomes for children and families.
Act a key link between health services and partner agencies and signpost where necessary
Provide health advice to the Integrated Front Door regarding health-related concerns.
Complete service requests if necessary to enable other health-based services to be accessed.
Act as a key link between the Integrated Front Door and SPA.
Provide professional challenge and if necessary, undertake escalations within the service, wider Children's Services and with partner agencies.
Support in delivering training in conjunction with the Integrated Front Door to the wider partnership in respect of threshold and support understanding of safeguarding legislation, policies / procedures and initiatives. Develop a communication strategy to ensure that own and partner agencies are aware of relevant updates and have increased knowledge.
Attend team meetings and group learning with the Integrated Front Door. Maintain own professional development in line with requirements of own substantive post and NMC.
Manage your own time and deliver objectives and targets ensuring the development of professional practice and updating knowledge of local and national changes linked to area of work.
