Job Title: Enhanced Communication & Language Impairment Provision for Students (ECLIPS): Peripatetic SEN ECLIPS Teacher

PURPOSE OF JOB: To work as part of the Extended Communication and Language Impairment Provision for Students (ECLIPS Team) to provide teaching, assessment and advisory support for pupils aged 4 – 25 with Developmental Language Disorder (DLD) / Speech and Language Communication Needs (SLCN).

MAIN DUTIES (ECLIPS Teacher):

1	To be conversant with the SEND Code of Practice, 2015.
2	To promote the work and objectives of Lincolnshire County Council through the Extended Communication and Language Impairment Provision for Students.
3	To work in partnership with Speech and language therapists, specialist teachers, EPs, Education Officers, Head Teachers, SENCOs, Teachers, Teaching Assistants and parents in order that the needs of learners who have SLCN can be met.
4	To deliver programmes of work to identified pupils requiring an 'enhanced plus' level of support (aged 4 – 10 years) and to those requiring ECLIPS support (aged 10 – 25 years).

5	To help build capacity across whole schools with regard to SLCN with other team members and SALT colleagues.
6	To share examples of best practice and effective interventions at the following levels <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Individual pupils ○ Groups of pupils ○ Whole class ○ Whole school
7	To work with parents and other agencies as appropriate
8	To maintain records of work undertaken
9	To liaise with all relevant partners during transition of pupils
10	To monitor and evaluate the progress and attainment of pupils with SLCN
11	To provide INSET as appropriate
12	To contribute to the review meetings of any pupils being supported by the team
13	To attend countywide CPD activities in the area of speech, language and communication
14	To undertake additional training in meeting the needs of pupils with SLCN to ensure excellent contemporary professional practice.
15	To be familiar with a wide range of resources, initiatives and strategies to assist in the planning of programmes to meet the needs of learners with SLCN.
16	To attend all Service staff training meetings/events as appropriate
17	To keep abreast of current SEN practice and research
